

Lesson Plans Week 2

Monday, March 23th - DAY 1

Reading. Today is a day one and students are introduced to a new story from STORYTOWN. Please refer to the Fridge Copy. Please read "The Science Fair". Discuss the story and ask your child the questions on page 371. Read "Meet the Author and Illustrator". Read "Advice from Dr. Fix-It". Compare the texts using the questions from page 376. Complete page 238 from the Practice Book Packet. Continue working on the same sort words.
