## NYCSD Covid Update and Information

### Update from Superintendent Kirkpatrick

In its Special Board Meeting (on 10/14/21), the Board and Administration had productive discussions on matters related to the District's Health and Safety Plan and the PA Mask Order.

The board intends to continue discussion in subsequent board meetings on the following:

- Drafting and discussing a Board Resolution pertaining to the Department of Health's Face Covering Order
- Discussing District practices related to the following:
  - Quarantining recommendations for students identified as close contacts
  - Reimbursing students for COVID-related testing
  - Enforcing mask compliance for indoor sporting, extracurricular, and community events within our facilities
- Discussing the District's ARP ESSER Health and Safety Plan and potential updates to ensure the plan reflects current practices

Also, for your awareness, there are [FAQs on the Face Covering Order](#) posted to our COVID webpage. The answers seek to clarify **why** and **how** we go about following the Order.

The final Q & A in the document addresses requests for students to wear **mesh masks** while in school. We reached out to the Department of Health for clarification and mesh masks do not meet the Department of Health definition of an appropriate face covering. Inquiries/questions should be directed to 1-877-724-3258.

### Mesh Masks Not Permitted

This communication is to clarify that **mesh masks** do not meet the department of health mask definition. With this, your student will be provided a school mask, should a mesh mask be worn. Inquiries/questions regarding mesh masks should be directed to 1-877-724-3258.

## Physical Education Update

Our Physical Education teachers continue to follow the direction of the mask order, requiring masks indoors, when students are not distanced 6 feet. Our teachers are prioritizing classes outdoors to support mask-free activities. When this is not possible, masks are required if students are close to each other and when movement is not high intensity.

*Per the Mask Order, when indoors, masks are off when:*

Participating in high intensity aerobic or anaerobic activities, including during a physical education class, in a well-ventilated location and when able to maintain a physical distance of six feet from all other individuals.
