Children should not wear jewellery to school. Those with their ears pierced are allowed to wear a small pair of stud earrings. This is for their own safety.



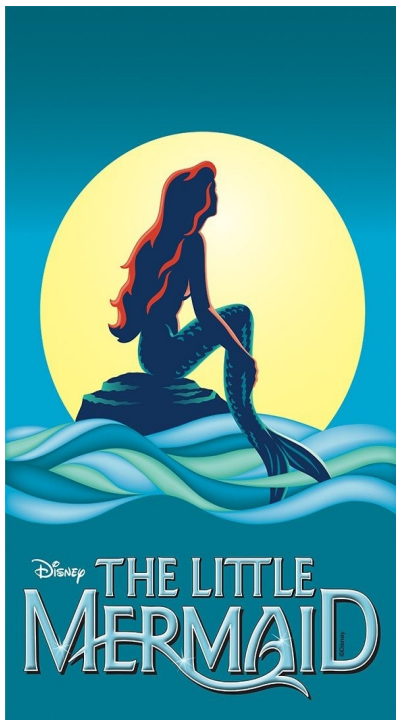
Come in to Connect
