The District has learned of one case of COVID-19 at Wellsville Elementary and one case at the high school.

The case at Wellsville is a student last in the building on Friday, March 12. Wellsville is currently closed and will still reopen as scheduled on Friday, March 19.

The case at the high school is a student last in the building on Wednesday, March 10. This is the third case for the high school within the current rolling 14-day period (six cases require a closure).

The District has taken action in accordance with the guidelines of the PA Department of Health (DOH) and the protocols established in the district's Health and Safety Plan, including consultation with the DOH, contact tracing, quarantining individuals that were in close contact, and appropriate cleaning and disinfecting of affected areas.
