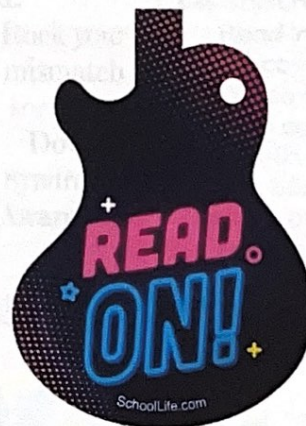
Dear Johnson Families,

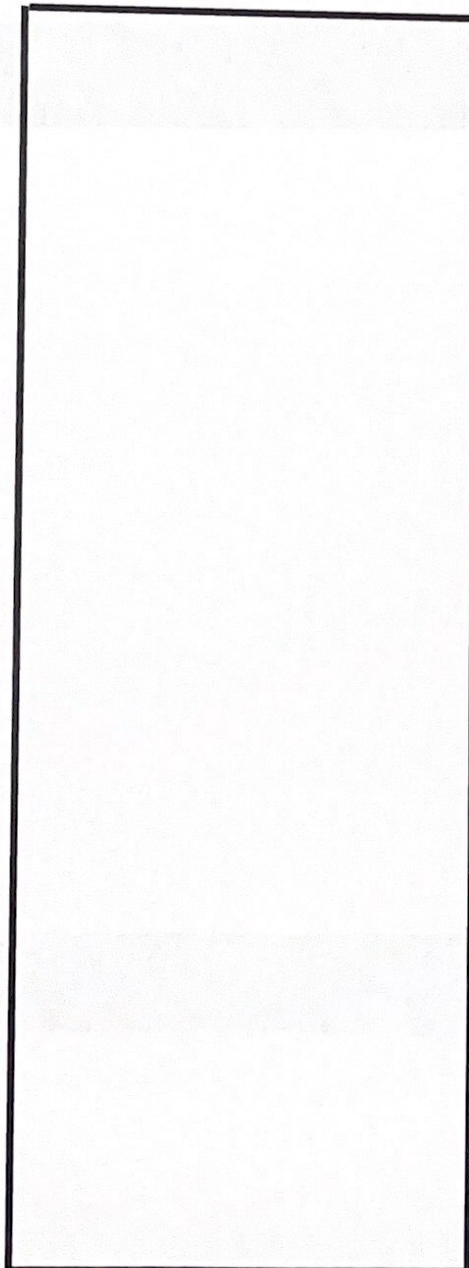
