





Principal's Leadership Group - Snapshots of What's Happening

6th Grade Science

Modeling is an important Science and Engineering Practice. Modeling helps our students process information, communicate prior knowledge, keep track of their growing conceptual understanding, and ultimately demonstrate mastery of concepts. Students use modeling to 'show what they know' in unique and interesting ways.
