Updates/Feedback

A. Team Development Activities

- 1. **Pre-Season Picnic Post Scrimmage Picnic**-Worked well; Freshman parents thought it was great. Maybe do a Time to Sign-up so we know what we are getting. Mike Freyermuth agreed—maybe bring a canopy and a table...it was great the girls were playing so the boys were able to see them
- 2. **Bowling Outing After Tryouts** The boys commented that they enjoyed it. There were teams so everyone got to know one another.
- **B.** Update on Team Room-Gaz and sons cleaned up and organized. Diane Shop-Vac room. Posters on the wall and the boys have been using it before practices. Posters are soccer inspirational.
- **C. Update on Bench Project-** Mike researched three different bench types of various sizes with various covering. The girls soccer team is ready to purchase; however, we have not been able to make contact with them. The benches do fold. If we want them on wheels we can get them. This would allow us to store them in the off-season. Mr. Schwille did say storage may be an issue. The largest bench as 12 seats, so would 12 be enough. The coaches have not looked at the options yet. Once the benches are chosen, we need to get Schwille's approval as well as the school board.
