1) Timeline for Boys Soccer

- 2) 2016 Budget
 - Please see attached proposed budget
 - Several discussion items:
 - a) Suggested keeping the income for the program at \$700 because that is what it would cost if we are not able to do the layout.

- b) Income for sportswear has been very low. Discussed using a different vendor for the sportswear sales. Kevin Zinn's company was suggested. Kelly Kozain will check into this option and head up sportswear this year.
- c) Increase keeper uniforms to \$500 to replace keeper uniforms if needed.
- d) Senior gifts will be increase to \$450 (\$50 per senior based on 9 seniors)
- e) Increase Camp Assistance to \$75 per player for a soccer came when receipt is turned in.
- f) Increase Travel Snacks to \$2500 with an understanding that no more than \$200 to be spent per away weekday game.
- g) Under income, separate the line item *Donations/Fundraisers* so there is no confusion.
- h) Under expenses, change socks to socks/miscellaneous uniform items
- i) Closer to the season, look into donation money from Sheetz
- j) What happened to the net to keep balls from going down the bank? We will contact Mr. Schwille to find out about this project.
- Potential purchases to add into Budget estimates need to be obtained before the next meeting.
