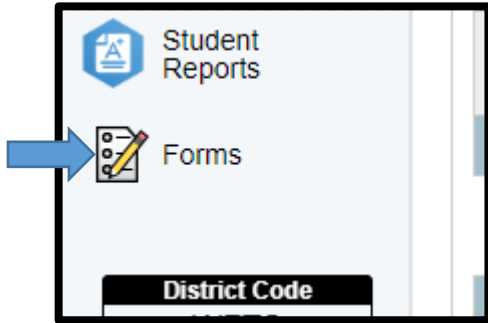




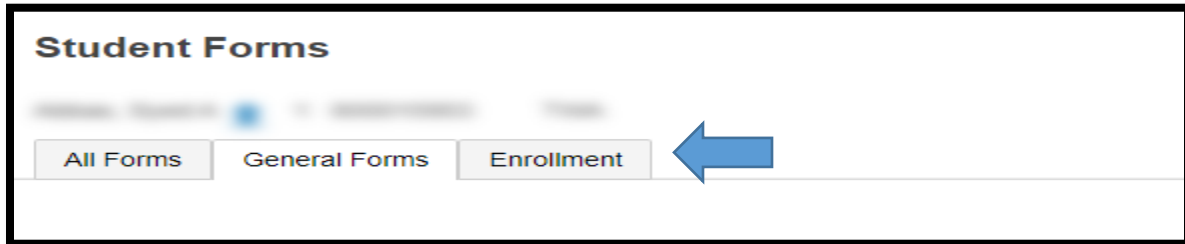
## Summer Program 2024 Enrollment Job Aid

*Follow the instructions below to enroll your student in Summer Quest enrichment or Summer Explorers invitation-only program.*

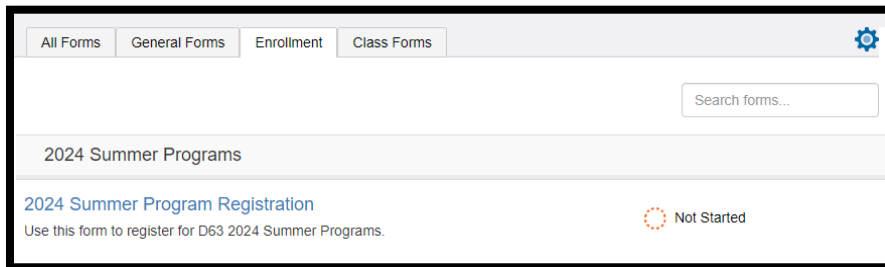
Log into the D63 [Parent Portal](#). From the left-hand menu, choose **Forms**.



Select the **Enrollment** tab



Click on **2024 Summer Program Registration**



If you wish to translate the page into Spanish, click the dropdown button on the top right side of the page and choose Spanish (see next page).



Options listed on the **2024 Summer Program Registration** page will automatically include all those for which your child is eligible.

### Summer Quest enrollment ONLY:

### District 63 Summer Programs

Monday, June 24 - Thursday, July 18, 2024

Enrollment in both Summer Quest and Summer Explorers runs **Monday, March 11 - Friday, April 30**.

**Summer Quest (Enrichment)** - open to all registered D63 students - offers two sessions each afternoon from 1:15 - 3:30 p.m. Session #1 runs June 24-27 AND July 1-3; Session #2 runs July 8-11 AND July 15-18. Due to limited availability, students may only attend one session.

**Summer Explorers** - open only to qualified students - Programs run June 24-27, July 1-3, July 8-11, and July 15-18. The hours of the program are 8:15 a.m. - 12:15 p.m.

### Multilingual Learner (ML) + Summer Quest enrollment:

The enrollment page for students who qualify for ML/Dual Language Summer School will look like the screenshot below.

- Select **Yes** if you plan to enroll your student in ML summer school.
- Click **Yes** or **No** to enroll in the Summer Quest enrichment program and follow the instructions listed above for selecting sessions, classes, and transportation. Click the **submit** button on the bottom right when finished completing the enrollment page.

**Multilingual Learner (ML) Summer School**

Students who qualify for Dual Language classes, or English language/bilingual services, are eligible to participate in this program that provides language instruction and academic support for English learners. Free breakfast provided every day. Materials and transportation are provided free of charge. Students enrolled in K-3 during the 2023-2024 year will attend Metzer, 4-7 will attend Apoto.
