 - Supporting transition to MS or HS

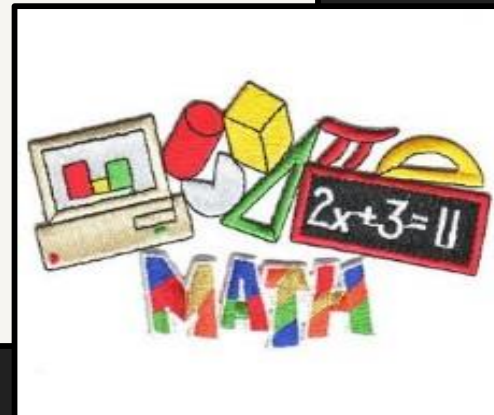
