NURSING OPTION - Navy ROTC INFORMATION

- Available to students interested in pursuing Bachelor of Science degree in nursing (BSN)
- Available only at a university that has a Navy ROTC affiliation and offers a state approved or National League of Nursing (NLN) approved bachelor's degree in nursing.
- If selected for scholarship, selectee must major in a nursing degree program leading to BSN
- On graduation, Nurse Option midshipmen commissioned as regular officers in Navy Nurse Corps
- While in program, male and female students participate in Navy ROTC and are referred to as midshipmen

Complete the following courses:

1. *Introduction to Naval Science*
 2. *Seapower and Maritime Affairs*
 3. *Leadership and Management I and II*
- Participate in weekly Navy ROTC drill instruction periods
 - Participate in two summer training periods of four weeks

Alongside nursing degree requirements, midshipmen will participate in physical fitness and leadership training and take several Naval Science courses, all designed to prepare them for future careers in the Navy Nurse Corps. Some schools are home to both a nursing school and an NROTC program, and others are in cross-town partnerships to offer their nursing students a chance to join the NROTC of a nearby school.
