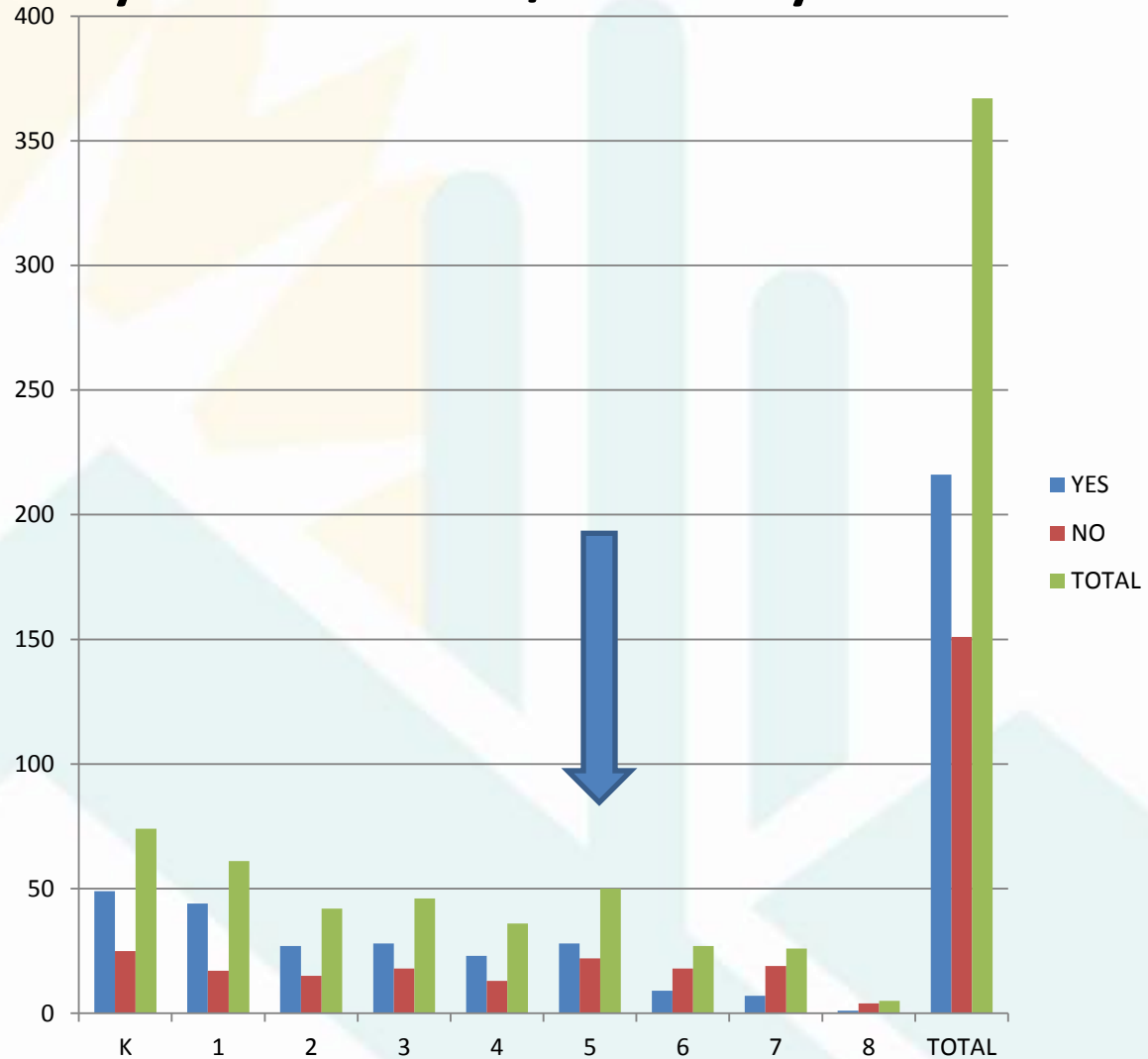

Timeline

- Community Forum—May 15, 2012
- Data collection/analysis of results of survey—by June 1, 2012
- Governing Board Presentation—June 5, 2012
- 2012/2013—Planning Year
 - Commitment Letter from 6th grade class (Nov. 1, 2012)
Contingent upon commitment...
 - Identify additional budget capacity to make model work
 - Recruitment of teachers—6th grade teacher will need to also be HQT.
 - Ongoing K-8 committee discussion/forums
 - Identify staff Professional Development Needs
- Potential Bond for Kiva K-8 facility (Fall 2013)
- Earliest possible K-8 facility (if approved)—2016/2017 SY

Commitment

- Minimum enrollment of 60 students with a maximum of 120 beginning the 2013/2014 school year.
- Parents should commit to keep their child in the K-8 structure for 3 years (grades 6,7,8). This helps with the continuity of our goals, curriculum and staffing consistent with a K-8 structure.
- Transportation to and from school, if the child lives outside the school boundaries, will be the responsibility of parents.

Fiscal Impact

Year 1 (13/14) : implementation of 7th grade

- 60 students - minimum of 2.8 FTE - Cost of \$116,000 (Average teacher salary of \$45,000)
- 120 - minimum of 5.6 FTE - Cost of \$252,000
