<b>Family/Student Fees</b>		
<b>Application Fee</b>	<p><b>NEW Families:</b> This <i>nonrefundable fee</i> is paid <b>at the time of initial application</b>.</p> <p><b>CURRENT Families:</b> Application Fees are waived for families with a currently enrolled student in the RCS system as long as the New Sibling Application is submitted by 12/15/2023 (<i>a \$50 fee will apply for new sibling applications received after this date</i>).</p>	<p><b>\$150/First Student</b> <b>\$50/Each Sibling</b> <b><i>due with application</i></b></p>
<b>Enrollment Fee</b>	<p>This <i>nonrefundable fee</i> is paid <b>yearly</b> and is due at the time of enrollment/re-enrollment. This fee pays for yearly account administrative functions and also holds the student's class placement.</p> <p><b>NEW Families:</b> New Student Application must be submitted by February 2 to receive <b>PRIORITY</b> enrollment fee discount of \$250 (for new families enrolling a first child in grades K-12). Applications received after February 2 and on or before May 1, will receive a \$100 enrollment fee discount.</p> <p><b>CURRENT Families:</b> <b>ALL</b> re-enrollment steps must be complete by March 1 to receive a \$250 <b>PRIORITY</b> discount off of the enrollment fee. Re-enrollment completed after March 1 and on or before May 1 will receive a \$100 enrollment fee discount.</p>	<p><b>\$550/Family</b> <b>\$250 PRIORITY discount by Priority Deadline</b> <b>\$100 discount by May 1</b> <b><i>due upon enrollment/re-enrollment</i></b></p>
<b>Enhancement Fee</b>	By volunteering in the school community beginning June 1, 2024 through May 31, 2025, this <b>yearly fee</b> is reimbursed to the family's account at the rate of \$15 per volunteer hour.	<p><b>\$150/Family</b> <b><i>due upon enrollment/re-enrollment</i></b></p>
<b>Student Fee</b>	<i>*Phased increase in fee.</i> This <b>yearly fee</b> covers the cost of the student yearbook, admission to home sporting events, emergency preparedness materials, and required standardized testing expenses. This fee also covers expenses for classroom supplements, co-curricular programs, book rentals, 6 <sup>th</sup> grade science camp, the annual retreat for grades 7 and 8, and expenses related to promotion. This fee also covers the cost of your student's Chromebook, relevant software, and support services. For students enrolling in grade 6 and continuing through grade 8, this yearly fee covers the entire cost of the Chromebook (including software). For students enrolling in grade 7 or 8, a buyout option will be available.	<p><b>*\$700/6<sup>th</sup> Grade Student</b> <b>\$650/7<sup>th</sup> &amp; 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Student</b> <b><i>due by June 1 or upon enrollment/re-enrollment</i></b></p>
<b>Athletic Fees</b>	There are no additional fees for sports, however, there may be expenses for spirit packs and uniforms. For Football, there is a \$100 helmet reconditioning fee due by the first practice. PE Uniforms are required for all students in PE classes and can be purchased in the front office.	<p><b>\$20/PE Uniform Set</b></p>
<b>Extended Care</b>	<p>The yearly <i>discounted</i> Extended Care Plans are available for purchase beginning 5/1/24 through 8/13/24 (monthly payments available). These plans cover any amount of extended care during the regular school year excluding late charges.</p> <p><b>Discounted Extended Care Plan</b> includes unlimited extended care on all school days as well as the RCS Golf Tournament (September 16).</p> <p><b>Discounted Extended Care Plan +</b> includes unlimited extended care on all school days as well as 19 holidays and professional development days.</p> <p><b>Drop-In Extended Care</b> is available before school from 6:30am and after school until 6 pm at a rate of \$10.50/hour (<i>billed in 30-minute increments</i>).</p>	<p><b><i>Discounted Extended Care</i></b> <b>\$2,150/year</b></p> <p><b><i>Discounted Extended Care +</i></b> <b>\$2,870/year</b></p> <p><b><i>Drop-In Extended Care</i></b> <b>\$10.50/hour</b></p>
<b>Miscellaneous Fees/Costs</b>	Additional costs include split financial accounts, special instructional supplies, replacement locks, instrument rentals and damage deposit, band/choir attire, expenses relating to field trips and class trips, SOAR, class pictures, 8 <sup>th</sup> Grade Washington DC Trip, and special events. There is an additional cost for students who require an aide as part of their Special Education services; that cost is dependent upon the percentage of time an aide is required.	<p><b>Varies</b></p>
