- Moving Compass to middle of day
- Increase academic catch-up days
- Dividers for urinals – Saira Joseph mentioned her boys don't use bathrooms here at WBMS because of this issue
- Members of SGC will be reaching out to county on urinal issue

Bell schedule change – sounds like we will maintain current schedule

New math standards state mandated – Mr. Nathan Amrine, guest speaker

Impacts:

- standards in each math course
- courses available
- pathways students take in future

95 families in limbo:

- Those with children who take 3 semesters of math in one year
- all algebra honors and ½ geometry honors in one year
- working to help families figure out how to retrieve this ½ year
- This is not a new math or a new set of standards – state re-packaging standards in a way that makes more sense, cleaning up the pathways

½ year kids Virtual options:

- FVS, teacher-led – fee based
- Content through modules, student-directed – free – offered spring or summer, student-paced
- Parents upset with county for not having math transition plan

ELA will be changing in the future, but Ms. Williams says ELA is more clear-cut
