Motions are the most basic and most used skill in cheerleading. Motions make the squad look uniform and sharp when done correctly. The following should be considered:

Stiff, sharp motions

No Broken Wrists – The wrist should be in a straight line with the arm. Make a fist with the thumb on the ring finger.

Body Alignment – Stand up straight, arms at your side

Feet – Should be flat on the floor with the toes facing the crowd. Apart or together?? – Everyone should be the same

Move the whole squad for transitioning – always be centered on the floor and utilize the whole squad.

Jumps:

Keep toes pointed

Hit a T motion at the top of the jump

Bend knees slightly to absorb the landing

Don't worry how high the jump is, rather keep the jump clean.

Always have a clean finish

No Poms can be used when tumbling and you may not cradle if holding signs.

Watch climbing technique in mounts and be sure the building is symmetrical.

Not all squads will have the good fortune to have skilled gymnasts, but you can use what you have. This category will be judged on how you have incorporated what you have into the routine. If you use gymnastics in the routine, be sure it looks great. If back handsprings are not good and clean, use a round off instead. Same is true for partner stunts.

2019 SUPER SATURDAY CHEERLEADING COMPETITION COACHES INFORMATION

EBL Cheerleading has gone through a number of changes in the Cheerleading Competition. Many of you have given thoughts (as have coaches in the past) as to how the competition should be modified or even changed from a competition to only a performance. It was felt that competition is the best way to encourage growth and improvements and very worthwhile to continue. With that in mind, it was decided to use the format upon which this league is based.

The purpose of the BCSC Elementary Basketball League (EBL)/Cheerleading Division is to provide youngsters the opportunity to learn the fundamental skills of cheerleading: to instill in youngsters the positive attitude necessary to successfully compete in a non-hostile, wholesome environment; to teach youngsters that "successful competitors" are those that adhere to the rules and spirit in which they are written and are those that give their best efforts in practices, games, and above all, in the classroom.

BCSC ELEMENTARY BASKETBALL LEAGUE REGULATIONS AND GENERAL CONCEPTS CHEERLEADING, I. PURPOSE

We are taking the competition back to the basics and our scoring will be based on the mastery of the BASIC skills that should be learned at the fifth/sixth grade level. Please remember that it is not how difficult the skills, but how well they are performed. Your best reference for this competition would be the materials given to you at the beginning of the season: EBL Regulations and General Concepts – Cheerleading and EBL Cheerleading Rules. This will be enforced and you will need to follow these. Also, I gave a handout early on which I used on the SCORE SHEET (Explained)

COMPETITION ROUTINE

The competition routine may consist of any number of cheers and chants. The time limit on this routine is **2** (**TWO**) **MINUTES**. This routine should NOT include music or dance. Again, judging will be based on what should be expected from fifth/sixth grade cheerleaders. Penalties will be assessed on EBL rules and Super Saturday Rules. Again this year, Lynley will be our technical judge as she is familiar with our rules. Any questions regarding your routines may be addressed to her (812) 603-7941.
