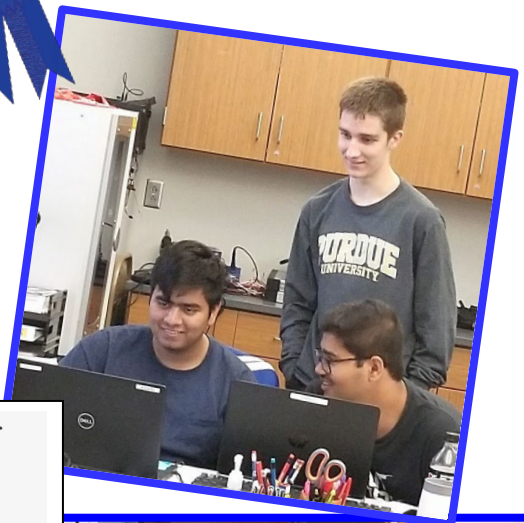
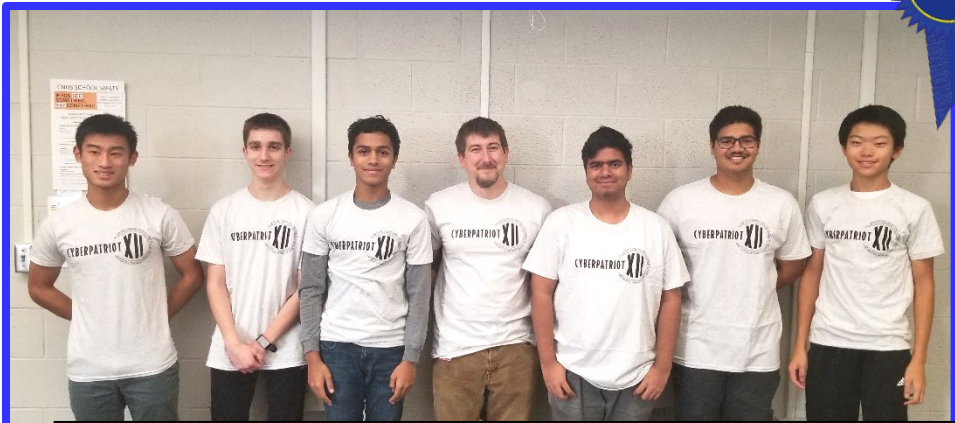

The Maverick Challenge is a high school business plan competition that focuses on innovative ideas and business concepts.
