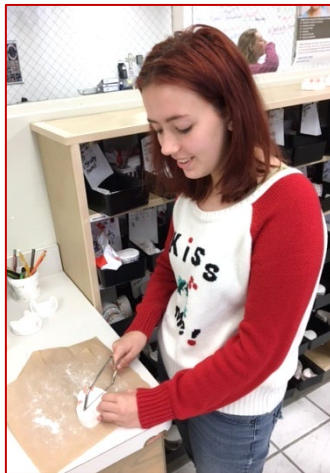
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C⁴ will connect community resources to provide career education for all students while laying the foundation for life-long learning.
