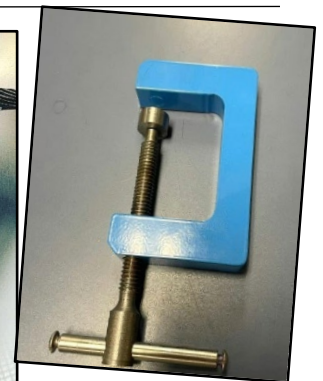
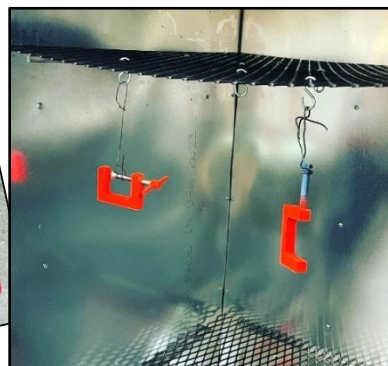
DENTAL CAREERS

Criminal Justice

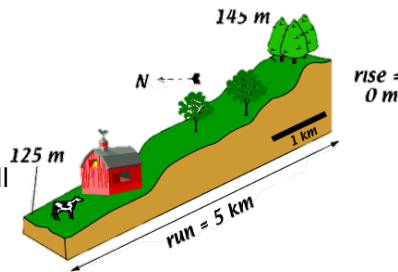
