In order to develop social awareness, students must understand that all actions have consequences and their actions and consequences can, and often do, affect others.

In this lesson your child learned the consequences for being honest. When your child is deciding to be honest or not, encourage him or her to stop and THINK and ask him or herself if the words are:

True

Honest

Inspiring

Nice

Kind

Here are a few ways you can help your child value honesty and choose to be honest:

- Model being honest with your child. By being honest with your child at an age appropriate level, you will show him or her that you value and practice honesty.
- When your child does say something that is dishonest, work together to determine what the consequence of that dishonesty is and how being honest would have changed the outcome of the situation.

Learning that actions have consequences and ways to be honest will help your child use his or her words for good!
