## Grade 2: Weekly Phonics Focus

### Lesson 22

In our classroom this week, we are learning to read and spell words with the **silent letters** **gn, kn, mb, and wr**. Here are the letters and patterns to practice this week:

<b>Consonants</b>	b, c, d, f, g, h, j, k, l, m, n, p, q, r, s, t, v, w, x, z y at the beginning of a word
<b>Vowels</b>	a, e, i, o, u y at the end of a word
<b>Silent Letters</b>	Silent letter patterns have 2 consonants side by side with 1 consonant remaining silent.

Here are some examples of words with the silent letters *gn, kn, mb, and wr*:

<b>gn</b> <i>(/n/ as in gnome)</i>	<b>kn</b> <i>(/n/ as in knight)</i>	<b>mb</b> <i>(/m/ as in comb)</i>	<b>wr</b> <i>(/r/ as in wrist)</i>
gnarl	knee	crumb	wrap
gnash	knew	lamb	wrist
gnaw	knife	limb	wrong
gnome	knit	numb	wrung
