Grade 2: Weekly Phonics Focus

Lesson 20

In our classroom this week, we are learning to read and spell words with **vowel-r phonograms** *air/are, ear/ere, and oar/ore*. Here are the letters and patterns to practice this week:

Consonants	b, c, d, f, g, h, j, k, l, m, n, p, q, r, s, t, v, w, x, z y at the beginning of a word
Vowels	a, e, i, o, u y at the end of a word
Vowel-r Phonograms	A vowel-r phonogram is a series of letters that represents 1 or more sounds.

Here are some examples of words with vowel-r phonograms *air/are, ear/ere, and oar/ore*:

-air	-are	-ear	-ere	-oar	-ore
air	bare	clear	here	board	ore
pair	blare	fear	mere	hoard	core
fair	dare	gear	sere	roar	more
hair	rare	near	sphere	soar	tore
