Grade 2: Weekly Phonics Focus

Lesson 26

In our classroom this week, we are learning to read and spell words with a **consonant-le**. Here are the letters and patterns to practice this week:

Consonants	b, c, d, f, g, h, j, k, l, m, n, p, q, r, s, t, v, w, x, z y at the beginning of a word
Vowels	a, e, i, o, u y at the end of a word
Consonant-le	The consonant-le pattern is 1 consonant plus the letter / followed by a vowel letter e at the end. The consonant-le pattern only occurs in multisyllable words.

Here are some examples of words with a consonant-le:

able	cycle	paddle	tremble
ample	dazzle	razzle	trundle
baffle	idle	scuffle	wiggle
battle	giggle	single	wobble
