## Grade 2: Weekly Phonics Focus Lesson 8

In our classroom this week, we are learning to read and spell words with the **vowel teams** ai, ay, oi, and oy. Here are the letters and patterns to practice this week:

<b>Consonants</b>	b, c, d, f, g, h, j, k, l, m, n, p, q, r, s, t, v, w, x, z y at the beginning of a word
<b>Vowels</b>	a, e, i, o, u y at the end of a word
<b>Vowel Teams</b>	A vowel team has 2 or more letters side by side that are pronounced as 1 vowel sound.

Here are some examples of words with the vowel teams *ai*, *ay*, *oi*, and *oy*:

<b>ai</b>	<b>ay</b>	<b>oi</b>	<b>oy</b>
braid	day	coil	boy
fail	gray	foil	coy
pain	Jay	moist	ploy
rain	May	oil	toy
wait	tray	point	Troy
