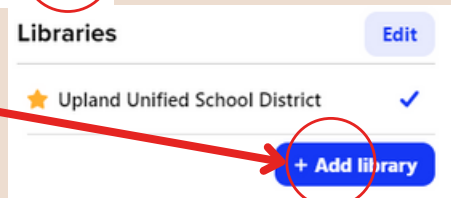
Did you know? - Students/ staff can add the public library to their Sora Account!

Step 1- Students and staff can login to Sora through Clever

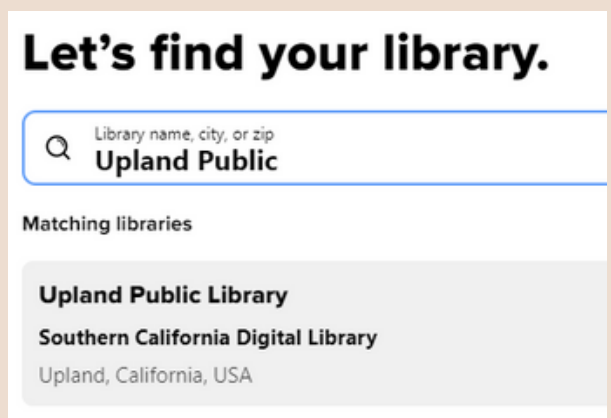
Step 2- Once logged in, students/ staff click on the button with three horizontal lines in the upper righthand corner



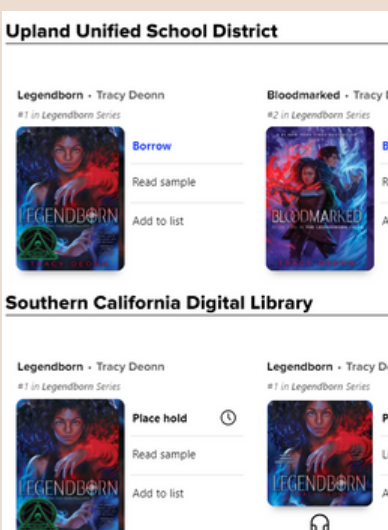
Step 3: Click on the “+Add library” button:
