



This week is Kindergarten testing

Reading

Students will be assessed on:

- all upper and lowercase letters.
 - This includes recognition, handwriting, blending CVC words, and connecting letters to their matching sounds.
- sounding out, reading, and writing consonant vowel consonant (CVC) words with the short vowels a, i, e, o and u.
- high frequency words learned to date.
- syllables.
- Capitalization, spacing, and punctuation.
- the pronoun I is always written as a capital letter.
- character, setting, main idea, and details

Math

Students will be assessed on:

- Counting to 100 orally
- writing and identifying numbers 0 – 20.
- orally count a set of 20 objects saying the number names in order.
- sorting and classifying objects into categories according to shape, size, and color.
- describing the relative positions of objects using terms such as above, below, in front of, behind, and next to.
- representing addition with objects and fluently add with a sum no greater than 5.
- representing subtraction with objects and fluently subtract with 5 being the largest number in the problem.
- identifying whether the number of objects is greater than, less than, or equal to the number of objects in another group.

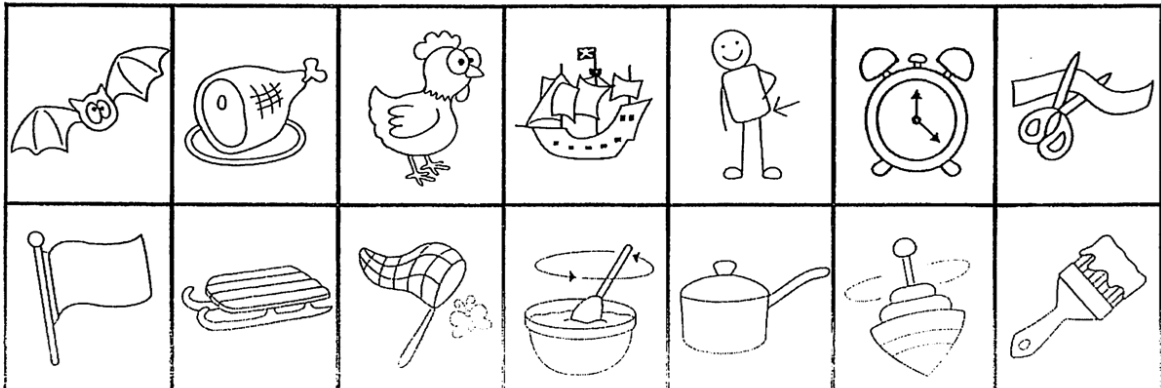

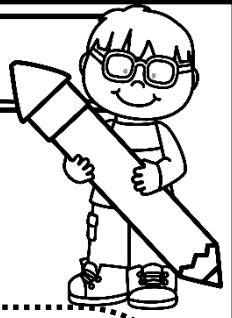
