As I reflect on the 2022–2023 school year, I am filled with deep gratitude for the blessings that unite us as a community. The theme that was selected for this school year was “Press On.” Our theme is inspired by *Hosea 6:3a* (NLT):

This year's theme is a reminder to all of us to lean into God's word, His truth, His love, our studies, our gifts and interests, our friendships, our sports and clubs, community service, and so much more so that we may draw closer to him in all that we do!

We are happy to share with you a few notable moments this past year that remind us that we remain committed to excellence in all things to bring glory to God:

- Our varsity boys and varsity girls basketball teams won their respective ILH D2 championships. Additionally, individual members of our teams also received top honors. From the boys team, Eli Shibuya '24 was recognized as the ILH D2 Co-Player of the Year and head coach Kellen Kaneshiro '00 was named the ILH D2 Coach of the Year. From the girls team, Joey Lin '23 was named the ILH D2 Player of the Year and head coach Robin Yamaguchi '77 was named the ILH D2 Coach of the Year.
- Our boys bowling team also claimed the state championship title, prevailing over the best public and private teams in the state..
- Our award-winning student journalism publication, *The Eagle Eye*, received high honors at the annual Hawaii High School Journalism Awards. Competing against public and private high schools, *The Eagle Eye* took home best-in-state awards across multiple categories. Six students were recognized at the state level—Brendan Aoki, Dilan Chock-Makiya, Noah Hu, Megan Lee, Cameron Pien, and John Yamamoto.

- High school students from the National Honor Society raised more than \$4,800 for the Hawaii Children's Cancer Foundation.
- HBA wins second place in Pacific Business News' Hawaii's Best Workplaces of 2022! The award honors the island's leading employers who foster an enjoyable and meaningful work environment for their employees.
- HBA Preschool at Gracepoint recognizes the accomplishments of our first class of students.
- Congratulations to the Class of 2023! Out of 117 graduates, 34 students were recognized as Sons and Daughters of HBA for attending the school since kindergarten. Twelve students were recognized as alumni Legacy graduates. Fifty-one students graduated with highest honors and 17 with honors.

The heart of our school beats with each family, child, and member of our faculty and staff. The combined commitment to nurturing not just academic growth but also the values of humility, curiosity, love and commitment is what makes our school community shine.

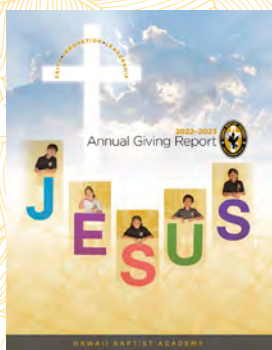

“Hi my name is Hannah Cheng and I am currently a junior at Hawaii Baptist Academy. At HBA, I am involved in the National Honor Society, the Ho’omana club, Soldiers of Light, and HBA’s tennis team. Outside of school, I am a part of my church’s worship ministry and I participate in performing arts.

Being able to attend Hawaii Baptist Academy has been such an incredible privilege. I still remember my first day at HBA in sixth grade. I was really nervous to be at a new school, in a new environment with new people. But I soon made friends and was welcomed into HBA’s amazing community. HBA has provided me and all my peers with great teachers who care, love, and support us so much. HBA has also given me the opportunity to surround myself with such a wonderful group of friends who support me, accept me, help me grow in my faith and in my character, encourage me through difficult challenges, and help me to persevere and try my best in any and every situation.

School has always been a challenge for me due to my perfectionist mindset. I always feel the need to do my absolute best and get high marks on every assignment and test. Many subjects like math don’t come very easily to me, so I have to work even harder to understand every concept. The fact that the work isn’t easy has pushed me to grow in my character, because character growth doesn’t happen when the work is easy, it happens when you do things that are hard and when you persevere

Forty-three mainland friends attended the 47th annual Mainland Advisory Council meeting, which took place on February 21–24. Pastor Deron Spoo of First Baptist Church in Tulsa, Oklahoma was the special guest devotional speaker.

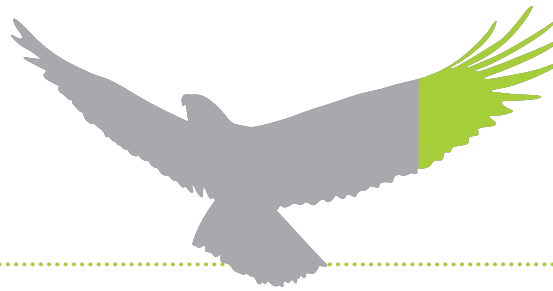

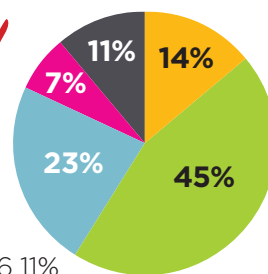

Leaving a Legacy Rooted in Faith and Education

Donald E. Lytal

July 18, 1930–August 3, 2019



Don served in the United States Army for almost four years. While stationed at Fort Belvoir, he attended First Baptist Church of Alexandria. There, he met, courted and married Dorothy “Dotty” Pruett. They were married for more than 65 years. With the GI Bill, he attended the University of Richmond and Southern Baptist

Theological Seminary in Louisville, Kentucky. He retired as the principal at Waynewood Elementary School and will also be remembered as a long-time mentor, educator, deacon and trustee at First Baptist Church of Alexandria.

Dorothy “Dotty” Lytal

August 10, 1931–July 21, 2021

Dotty was a beloved teacher at Fort Hunt Elementary School in Fairfax County, Virginia. In 1984, her teaching skills coupled with her demonstrated love for the individual student was publicly recognized when she was awarded the inaugural Washington Post Teacher of the Year Award for Fairfax County.

Their entire adult life was focused on engaging people on a very personal level. As a couple, parent, pastor, administrator/teacher, church leader, mentor and all other titles they held, Don and Dotty had an enduring characteristic of recognizing value in every individual

they knew. As an elementary school principal Don knew the name of every student and worked diligently to develop the potential in each. As a teacher, Dotty focused on the potential of each student and worked toward developing the best in them. It may be the norm today to focus on collective test scores, but for the Lytals, it would have been merely a byproduct of the achievements of every individual student.

In 1984, the Washington Post recognized Dotty's achievements by naming her as the first recipient of the teacher of the year award for Fairfax County. She also received a congratulatory letter from President Ronald Reagan. Her prize was a two week, all expense paid tour of the education system in Japan.

In 2006, Don and Dotty attended their first and only Mainland Advisory Council (MAC) meeting at Hawaii Baptist Academy. They were so impressed with the dual goals of faith and academics at HBA, and experienced the integration of both goals in the students, faculty and administrators they met. They decided then to leave a substantial portion of their assets to help HBA students in the future.

In August of 2022, upon their deaths, HBA was gifted with \$350,000 to establish the **Donald E. and Dorothy P. Lytal Scholarship Endowment**. HBA is forever grateful for the Lytals' love for the Lord and their commitment to providing an excellent Christian education to those who desire one. The Lytals were recognized during MAC Week 2023 for this gift.
