Literacy instruction for students with disabilities remains a top priority in FCS. Research shows that utilizing MindPlay is highly effective in helping students improve their reading ability. This is a very valuable resource that we are fortunate to be able to train and support our teachers in implementing.

### What is MindPlay?

- MindPlay is adaptive web-based software that provides reading instruction for students with disabilities through coaching and specific instruction.
- Progress monitoring assessments are embedded to identify learning gaps.

### How do we know it works?

- Lessons provided through MindPlay will continue until mastery is achieved.
- Research shows MindPlay has proven success amongst students with learning gaps.

### Who uses it?

High school special education students who:

- Are performing 2+ or more grade levels below in reading.
- Demonstrate labored reading (weak word-attack and word recognition).
- Psychological report indicates reading deficiencies in basic reading, reading comprehension, and/or reading fluency.

### How is it used?

- 150 minutes per week (i.e., 30 minutes per day).
- Engagement can occur during class.
- Teacher can assign MindPlay to occur outside of class.
