**6.a. Proposal for Course Revision - HS Accounting II to HACC - Principles of Financial Accounting I and Accounting II**

**Changing Accounting II to HACC - Principles of Financial Accounting I and Accounting II**

Changing the curriculum to offer more business courses for college credits is just keeping up with the current culture. Accounting II allows the students to take Accounting I before going all-in on a college course. The HACC course will revisit some of the concepts in Accounting I and introduce several new concepts that will help the students gain a competitive advantage in the field of accounting, while earning college credits towards accounting classes.

There will be a minimum grade requirement (80%) that a student needs to earn in Accounting I in order to take this class.

Students will be able to earn college credits and possibly not take the Financial Accounting class in college.
