The Greenheck Turner Community Center is committed to meeting community needs by providing opportunities for all in the areas of recreation, wellness, athletics, and social activities.



This weekend we sprang forward and headed into March. The anticipation is high as we approach the summer and the opening of the new building. Our center will offer a space for community members seeking indoor activities during the less favorable weather conditions of fall, winter and spring in Wisconsin. We are committed to keeping fitness center memberships accessible to all, ensuring affordability for everyone.

Our current facility has been abuzz with activity this spring, hosting a lot of events including athletic practices, tournaments, ice skating shows, hockey jamborees, and special events like the IMAGINE and the upcoming antique show. Indoor soccer has over 468 participants, while enrollment for summer soccer is now open.

The completion of painting, carpeting, lighting, and cement work marks significant progress. Soon, state-of-the-art sport simulators will be installed, featuring the latest technology for golf and offering virtual experiences in other sports such as softball, soccer, and dodgeball. These simulators will be available for hourly rental, operating seven days a week.

Additionally, we are nearing completion of four meeting rooms equipped with advanced technology for screen sharing and presentations. These rooms will be open to community members, nonprofits, and organizations starting this fall, providing versatile spaces for various activities.

To give our community a sneak peek into the new facility, we have produced a drone video showcasing the construction progress. We invite you to watch this short video and witness firsthand the exciting developments taking place at the Greenheck Turner Community Center.

Greenheck Turner Community Center will impact lives of children, families, adults, teams, organizations and the community with more than 50,000 community interactions a year.

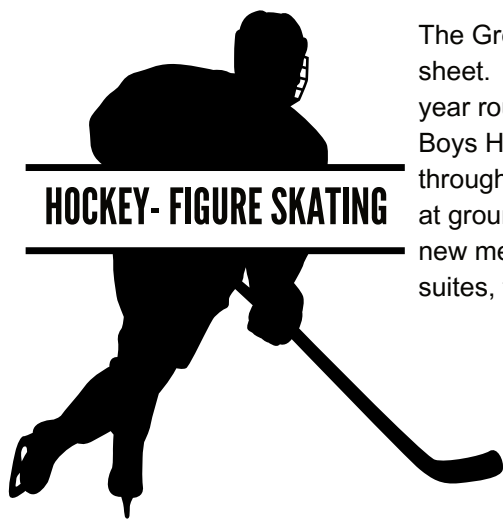

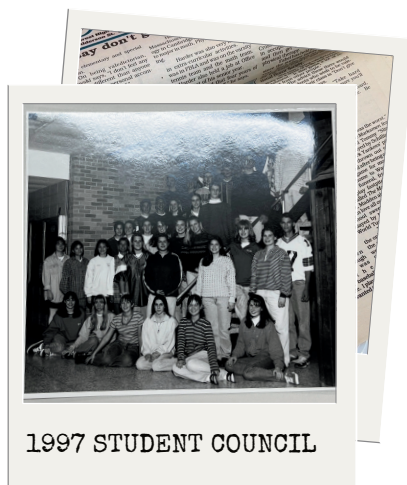

The Greenheck Fieldhouse was built in 1997 as a premier hockey arena and Olympic size ice sheet. Twenty-seven years ago hockey teams, ice skating clubs and speed skating used the ice year round. Today DC Everest Youth Hockey, State Champions Storm Girls Hockey, D.C. Everest Boys Hockey and Timberline Ice Skaters use the ice along with other camps and leagues throughout the year. The new glass door entrance will be much easier for hockey players to enter at ground level. (No more stairs for young players to carry bags up and down.) Three of the four new meeting rooms have windows that look into the ice arena and can be used for hospitality suites, team rooms for watching film and space for board meetings.

A few months ago the corner stone from the existing building was removed and a time capsule was unboxed. This copper box was filled with memorabilia from the students of 1997 and a copy of their newspaper, graduating program, and a CD from a student band. There were photos of a computer lab, science room and the construction of the Greenheck Fieldhouse.

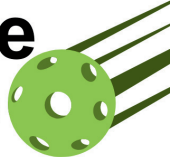
