### Informational Item: Principal's Update

- A. **Staffing update**-Due to student numbers, we lost one general education teacher and one ESOL teacher. Mrs. Alhadeff fought to keep teachers, and the county allowed one ESOL teacher and one general education teacher to remain at the school. Due to staffing changes, there were changes made to the master schedule.
- B. **Semester Action Plan**- Mrs. Alhadeff presented the semester action plan goals for the year. The goals are in the areas of relationships and routines, tier one instruction, and intervention. The goals are listed below for each category and grade level.
  - a. Relationships and Routines
    - i. By May 2024, student attendance will increase by 2%.
  - b. Tier One Instruction
    - i. Grades K-2: By May 2024, Vickery Mill will increase the percentage of students in grades K- 2 performing on or above grade level in i-Ready reading from 68% to 73% and in i-Ready math from 52% to 57%.

- ii. Grades 3-5: By May 2024, Vickery Mill will increase the percentage of students in grades 3- 5 who meet the reading indicator on Georgia Milestones ELA from 55% to 60% and who meet Developing or higher on Georgia Milestones math from 34% to 39%.

c. Interventions

i. Grades 1-2

- a. By May 2024, 80% of Vickery Mill students in grades 1-2 who began the year two or more grade levels below in i-Ready reading will meet their stretch growth target.
- b. By May 2024, 80% of Vickery Mill students in grades 1-2 who began the year two or more grade levels below in i-Ready math will meet their stretch growth target.

ii. Grades 3-5

- a. By May 2024, 60% of Vickery Mill students in grades 3-5 who began the year two or more grade levels below in i-Ready reading will pass the reading indicator on Georgia Milestones ELA.
- b. By May 2024, 60% of Vickery Mill students in grades 3-5 who began the year two or more grade levels below in i-Ready math will meet Developing or higher on Georgia Milestones Math.

- C. The YMCA provided a grant that will fund a shade structure over the second playground. Home Church has helped provide many items to help start the PBIS store as well as setting up volunteers to mentor students.

**Discussion Item: Charter Dollar Expenditure Proposals**

- A. The council brainstormed ideas of what to spend money on to benefit the students and schools. Suggestions included a track around the playgrounds at recess, wireless connections for teachers to connect computers to projectors, tinted windows for gym, incentives to encourage attendance and students arriving to school on time, PBIS semester celebrations, and field trips/experience allotment for each grade level.
