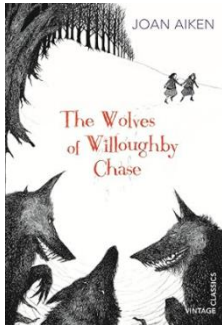


YEAR 5 STAFF'S BOOK RECOMMENDATIONS

- **Varjak Paw by SF Said**

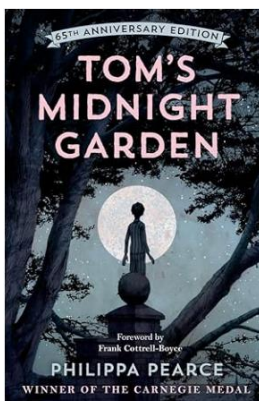
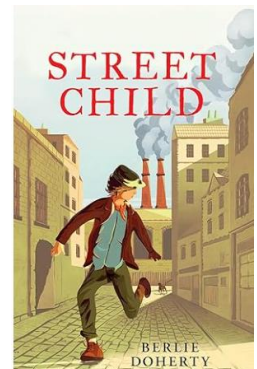
A courageous feline named Varjak Paw ventures beyond the confines of his home when his family is threatened to seek aid from legendary cats and master an ancient art

- **Wolf Brother by Michelle Paver**

Set in prehistoric times, Torak embarks on a perilous journey through the ancient forest, guided by his connection with a wolf companion, as they unravel secrets, confront dark forces, and strive to fulfill a destiny intertwined with the natural world.

- **Street Child by Berlie Doherty**

(Based on the real experiences of Victorian Children) Jim Jarvis navigates the harsh realities of Victorian London's streets after being orphaned, facing adversity, finding resilience, and seeking a sense of belonging.



- **The Midnight Fox by Betsy Byars**

A young boy's summer of self-discovery as he forms a profound bond with a wild fox which explores themes of nature, family and growing independence.

- **Tom's Midnight Garden by Philippa Pearce**

A lonely boy discovers a magical garden that allows him to travel through time, forging a heartfelt connection with all within it.

- **Clockwork (or All Wound Up) by Phillip Pullman**

A short but captivating tale of mechanical marvels and fantastical fables filled with suspenseful twists and turns.
