

Stonewall Tell Elementary School School Governance Council Meeting Summary

February 24, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 pm February 24, 2022. The motion to approve the agenda and minutes were approved, seconded, while all were in favor. Principal Porter shared the school budget recommendation and approval document for viewing purposes only. She proposed Math coach, Literacy coach 0.5 EIP Teacher, and a 10-month professional assistant as the priorities of the budget. In addition the projection for students and teacher allocations showed a decrease in the number of EIP teachers from 7 to 2.5 as well as a decrease in the number of students. Following the Principal's update was the council initiatives where there will be 3 vacancies for he next school year: school employee, community member, and a parent vacancy. At present one parent has expressed and interest. Dr. Weldon, chair of SGC, lead the discussion of successes and challenges with the council prior to this academic year. Understanding how to get more involved in the SGC process, principal Porter mentioned what has taken place under her leadership. She has placed SGC election information in the Tiger Talk, maintained close contact with district support, the school's website and posted on all social media platforms as well as reached out to volunteers and community members. The Action Items were charter dollar expenditures. One Book One School has been purchased. It is scheduled to start March 2^{nd} . There is \$12,805 left in the budget to spend. PBIS has been approved student books for One Book, One School, Exceptional Children's Week, SEC department requested \$1200 for the week. The request was voted on and approved. Council Member, Ms Mitchell asked for a reconciled list for next meeting in an effort to see the list of spending. The council voted and approved the budget presented by Principal Porter. The Agenda and next meeting is set for March 16, 2022. The meeting adjourned at 6:12pm.
