### School Governance Council Meeting Summary

January 12, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 5:37pm January 12, 2022. Request and approval of agenda and meeting minutes were moved to approve, seconded with all members in favor. Mrs. Porter gave the Principal's update sharing iReady data gains. Overall, the school has made growth on every grade level. Principal Porter proposed to spend the remaining funds on classroom libraries related to the iReady Reading data. In particular, using the idea behind *One School One book*, reading "The Wild Robot", which ties into SEL and would simultaneously support IB learner profiles is the book of recommendation. PTA's Boosterthon is a dance fit fundraiser, to raise funding for a book vending machine.
