Infinite Campus and FCS email is also being used. Fulton County Big Rocks started last year and is continuing this year, Tier 1 instruction and high dose of small group interventions of tier 3. STES only school in FCS engaged in Community School Yard Project. Started in September with a meeting with developers and students. The community is engaged in survey which is on the website. Will be used during the day by school/students after hour will be used by community. We have \$46, 390 in budget. Principal shared a list of items for approval. Which will be voted on next month. The list was based upon the needs that are gathered from student data. Safety and security is also recommended by Superintendent to use funding. Data: Also posted in Tiger Talk, 80% of students should be on grade level. 15% tier two and 3-5 on Tier 3 according to the state model. STES iReady Reading data shows 30% are performing at Tier 1, 43% at Tier 2 and 27% at Tier 3. In math 12% at Tier 1, 57% at Tier 2, and 32% at Tier 3.	Mrs Porter
