- 1. Be a resident of Idaho.*
- 2. Be a graduating senior of a Canyon/Owyhee County high school to include homeschooling programs.*
- 3. Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.*
- 4. Have demonstrated commitment to community service.*
- 5. Enroll as a full-time student in an accredited post-secondary educational institution.*
- 6. Attend the first semester of college following high school graduation (attending fall of 2024).*

Instructions:

- Complete the Caldwell Rotary Club Scholarship application using your best penmanship. If you have a computer, you may answer each question on a separate sheet of paper and attach it to the application. If using a computer, be sure to write your name on the Application and at the top of each of your additional pages of answers. Be sure to type your name at the top of the second answer sheet and each additional sheet thereafter before printing and stapling pages to the application.
- Include a copy of your transcripts for grades 9 through grade 12 that are currently on file at your school.
- Sign and return the statement that you will comply with terms of this award.
- Provide two letters of recommendation, one from a teacher or academic advisor, and one from someone in the community (not related to you) who has known you for 2 years or more. The reference letters will discuss your potential for success at the college level, your character, achievements, and your involvement in community service.
- Include High School Resume (if completed).
- Attach an essay of not more than 500 words sharing information about yourself, your academic interests, and your plans for the future.
