

Kyle R. DeVilbiss Memorial Scholarship

DeVilbiss was a 2006 graduate of Troy High School and a member of the Troy High School Band program including the Troy High Jazz Band. As a clarinet and piano player, his consistent “can do” attitude no matter what faced him, gained him the respect of his peers and teachers. He truly loved band and music in general. The Kyle R. DeVilbiss Memorial Scholarship was established by the Kyle R. DeVilbiss family for the purpose of assisting a college-bound Senior Band student to continue their education beyond high school. The recipient of the Kyle R. DeVilbiss Memorial Scholarship will receive a one-time gift of \$250.

The following document will outline Scholarship criteria and application deadlines.

Eligible students will meet the following criteria:

- Have participated in four years (8 semesters) of High School Band and be a graduating senior in good standing.
- Attending either a 2-year or 4-year college.
- GPA of 2.5 or higher.

Please provide the Selection Committee with an essay entitled “Why Music is Important”. Essay will be single-spaced and **no more** than full page.

If selected, recipient may be required to present a letter of acceptance from the college of their choice.

Application and essay must be submitted to Troy High School Guidance Office by April 1.
