	FY2023 budget -strategic priorities (alignment with outcome/initiatives); Budget Highlights (allocations and expenditures); Additional Fiscal Updates (charter dollars/ Title 1) -priority 1 – school improvement coach for literacy (big rock 2:tier 1 instruction) -Priority 2 – school improvement coach math k-5 (Big Rock 2) -Priority 3 – Full time counselor -FY22 8, 543, 570 -FY23 8. 076, 886 80% of this is personnel Allocations – 927 students (decrease from 1028), 39 k-5 teachers (down from 41), special area teachers remain the same (1.6 PE, 1.4 Art, 1.4 Music), 8 Special Ed teachers remain the same, 1.5 EIP (decrease), ESOL teachers remain the same, 2 regular preK classes remain the same, 2 gifted teachers remain the same, 1 k-2 literacy
