**Informational Item: Principal's Update**

- Phase 5
  - Full face to face instruction, but families have option to remain remote
  - About 35% of students are face to face
  - Families have varying reasons for remaining virtual: have a parent/ adult at home, COVID-19 concerns, it's been going well for them, parent working from home, don't have to worry about childcare, family member high risk
  - In-person classrooms vary in sizes (approximately 6-12 students per class)
  - What is in place now will remain through December. What will happen in the spring semester is still to be determined.
  - Teachers feel it has been beneficial having students return to the classroom (socialize)
