Can carry over up to 5% • new budget will be called FY21 and will come out soon – closes on 2/28 and must be voted on and approved by SGC Examples of budget spending: • teachers allotted 150 but asked to only spend about half until further notice (TW be approved to spend rest of money. update about that coming to teachers soon)	Mrs. Sharper
