Principal's Update: Pride Night postcards have been returned. Asking for address

confirmation. Math coach position has been reposted (Iris Im's replacement). WES received funds based on last year's CCRPI scores -- \$70,000 this year (\$80,000 last year). Three types of schools: flexible (A or B); tailored (C), intensive (F). Woodland is a Flexible school. We have more autonomy vs. Intensive schools. We have chosen to give fewer benchmark tests so that teachers have more time to teach. Even with larger numbers, we are not able to hire an additional data clerk.; APs help. We currently have 1,068 students. We are holding off on RFF process. GA Legislature is talking about longer summers. Community Partnership Survey to be done at October meeting. Gina Gill and Cheri Mills to meet to consolidate and create final community partnership list;

bringing to October SGC meeting.

FOW/PTO: \$29,000 in bank; PTO is doing a good job of bringing it in and sending it

out to the school/teachers. This year has been better year than any other year. Combined organization working great. Saving thousands of dollars. Fall Festival is coming up. March auction and possibly event (Shannon

Camp to run). Gina has list of partnerships.

Membership/sponsorship raised over \$7,612 (78% of the goal). Less teachers have sponsored than in the past; FOW does not want to ask teachers for money; wanted more as volunteers than money sponsors. What would make teachers want to do more? Do a by-grade sponsorship

for next year?

Read-a-Thon happening now -- at just under \$10,000 as of today; goal is \$16,000. Ends 9/30. Fall Carnival in October. Selling birthday messages on the marquee. Sold 60 in the first week. Goal is to cover the electricity

costs each month.

PTO started a Sunshine Fund for teachers/staff extenuating

circumstances.
