## SGC October Meeting Minutes

## Attendees: Mrs. A. Dallas, Dr. Brown, Dr. S. Hall, Ms. Graves, (Ms. Kemp), Mrs. Savage, Ms. Lisa Bones.

- At 2:11 p.m. Mrs. Dallas motioned to call the meeting to order Ms. Graves seconded. Motion carried.
- Action Items- Mrs. Dallas informed members about the upcoming Fall Cross Council Meeting. SGC members were informed about the purpose of the Cross-Council meeting.
- Mrs. Dallas asked if anyone wanted to volunteer to attend the upcoming Cross-Council meeting. Mrs. Dallas tabled selection of volunteers for the next meeting.
- Council Initiatives- Mrs. Dallas opened the floor for discussion. Mrs. Dallas stated there were two committees who could assist and reviewed the members listed on each committee thus far. Mrs. Dallas was added to the Finance Committee.

- Principal's Update-

- Dr. Brown reported the results from the Unit Assessment in ELA and Math for each Grade Level and discussed the comparison between where students were presently opposed to the previous school year. Ms. Bones asked about student proficiency data and why it appeared to be low.
- Dr. Brown stated that the school was optimistic about student improvements by Mid-Year and End-of-the Year based on the trends of 6<sup>th</sup> graders who typically take longer to adjust to their middle school transition.

- Dr. Hall asked if SGC could determine if they wanted to be a part of the Sports Concession night Fundraiser as our Athletic Director asked of us?. Mrs. Dallas suggested this be tabled for the next meeting.
