
Football

Engaging STEM & Character Project on Parade

It was a remarkable afternoon in the Elementary Media Center as Laura Young's Language Arts students gathered together for "Balloons Over Schumann: A Parade of Character." With vision and support from Bailey Nett, Instructional Technology Coach, students applied an amazing set of skills to imagine, plan, build, and program their Dash robots—complete with colorful balloon characters—to move along a parade route of skyscrapers. Student teams...

- were assigned a unique number of base-10 blocks (flats, longs, cubes) to create a varied skyline for the parade route (mathematics)
- selected a book character and explained how that character demonstrated a Pillar of Character (literacy & Character Counts)
- planned, designed and decorated a balloon to attach to their robot (design & engineering)
- used Blockly code to program Dash robot "floats" to follow the parade route (programming)

The students invited family members, guests and first-grade students to enjoy the show. **Well done!** Thank you to our students, Ms. Nett and Ms. Young.

Enrollment for the 2024-25 School Year

Enrollment is underway for the 2024-25 school year! Here are some details depending on whether you are...

- a resident family with an incoming Kindergartener -- please look for more information in December on next steps
- a potential open-enrolled family with an incoming Kindergartener -- please complete and return the online <u>Open</u>
 <u>Enrollment (OE) Application form</u> by the state deadline of January 15, 2024, to be included in the first round of

consideration. **NOTE**: An OE application is required to be on file by the deadline for each child, even if you already have a child enrolled in Orono Schools.

Early Childhood Screening Required. All children in the state of Minnesota are required to complete an Early Childhood Screening prior to Kindergarten enrollment. Early Childhood Screening is a free check of your child's development including hearing, vision, communication skills, motor skills, etc. Documentation of an Early Childhood Screening, completed by our district or a different district, is required. To schedule an Early Childhood Screening appointment in Orono, you can:


