

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# Launch



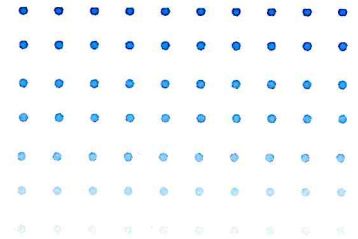
Online learning platform that is teacher led and paced for students. This is done in cooperation with the Springfield School District.

## Summit Technology Academy



Summit Technology Academy (STA) is a shared campus of junior and senior students who come together for a half-day program as an extension of their home high school. STA is a career-focused academy designed to prepare students for tomorrow's professional workforce.

- 9 Current students attending
  - Students from Holden are enrolled in the following programs: Business Finance/FinTech (1), Aero Space (2), DevSecOps (1), and Allied Health(1), Professional Nursing(2), Software Development(2)
  - All 4 out of 9 students are applying for next year (5 graduates)
  - 2 additional are applying for first year
  - Students must provide own transportation
  - Students pay a portion of the tuition

# WACC

## Warrensburg Area Career Center

WACC provides classes to a total of 7 area sending schools

26 HHS students currently attend

Available to 11th-12th grade students

Programs offered include:

AG Education, Auto Collision (8), Auto Service (8), Business, Computer Tech (1), Construction Tech (5), FACS, and Health Sciences (4).

- HHS Students receive elective credit as well as imbedded ELA/Math credit.
