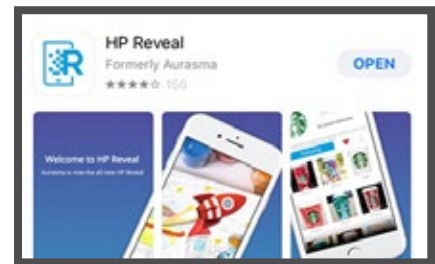

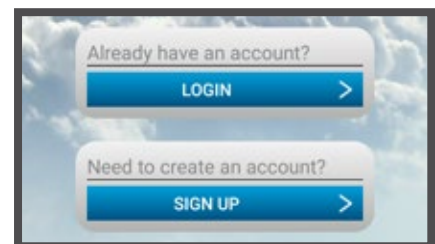

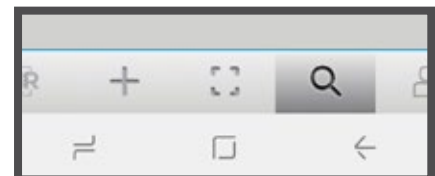

This year I am completing sixty years of service in education as a teacher, and administrator. I feel proud that my work has impacted, very positively, the futures of thousands of my students. A bright jewel in my career was that I founded and managed the American International School in Egypt (AISE). My reward is to see my dear students enjoy the learning process at the hands of outstanding teachers and administrators and to become lifelong learners after graduating from selective institutions of higher education. This is being accomplished now and in the years to come.

Throughout this long journey, I have received many awards including my induction, in the USA, into the Hall of Fame for International Education in 2005, by the Association for the Advancement of International Education (AAIE). I also received from the International Schools Association (ISA), which is an NGO of the United Nations, their award of Distinguished Service to International Education in 2006. Recently I received from the Mediterranean Association of International Schools (MAIS), their award of Outstanding Contributions to International Education.

In 1993, I started our school management organization; "Esol Education" which has founded and managed outstanding schools that currently serve about 11,000 students in many different countries.

My efforts with my colleagues, were focused in Arab countries. But now, we are looking forward to expand our educational services worldwide. The first fete was being selected over scores of schools and organizations, to start the American school Hong Kong, which will open its doors for instruction at the beginning of September 2016.

Our future plans include many other international schools wherever needed. As always they will be of very high quality, and where progress never stops.

At AISE, we are delighted to have our own, seventh grader Magda Azmy, and Mostafa Sherif, the eighth grader of the West Campus to be two winners out of five. The three other students are from international schools in London, Rome and Tangiers to receive the Mediterranean Association of International Schools' (MAIS); Robert Sills Award.

We are very proud of our school, its students, parents and outstanding faculty.

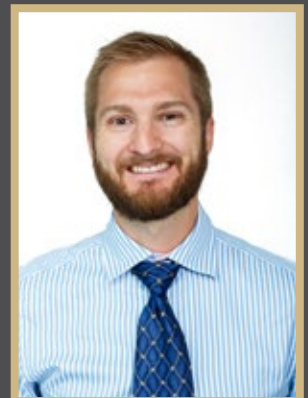
This has been an awesome year for me and I hope it has been the same for all of you.
