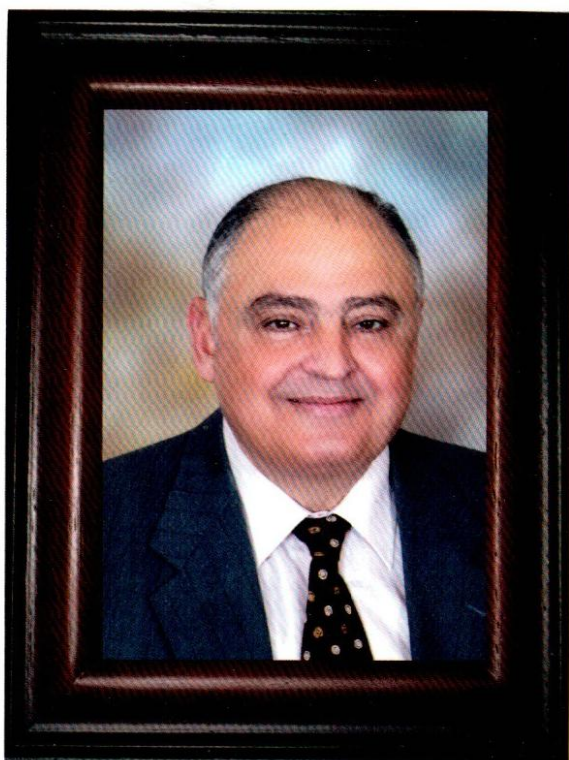

We hope this university will become a center of excellence in higher education to serve Egypt, Africa, the Arab countries and even attract some students from Europe and elsewhere.

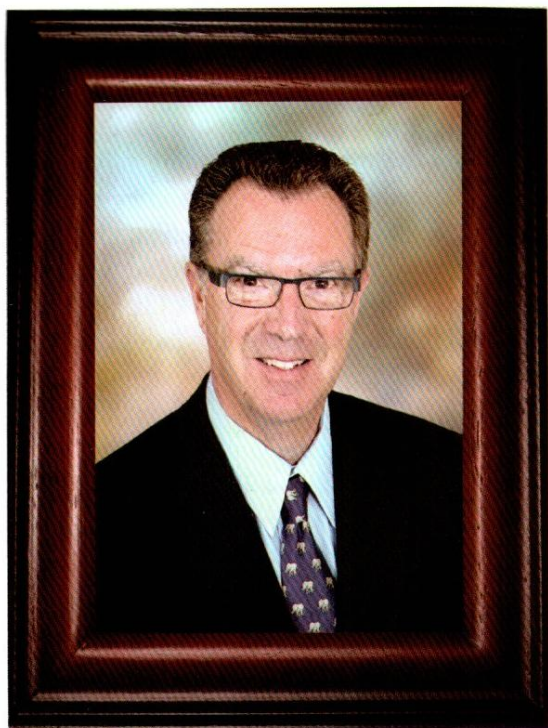
Having served for more than 50 years as an educator in the Arab countries, I feel happy and proud to announce the start of the university on the 20th anniversary of AISE.

**School** just started, high school students are just warming up, the weather is still hot.

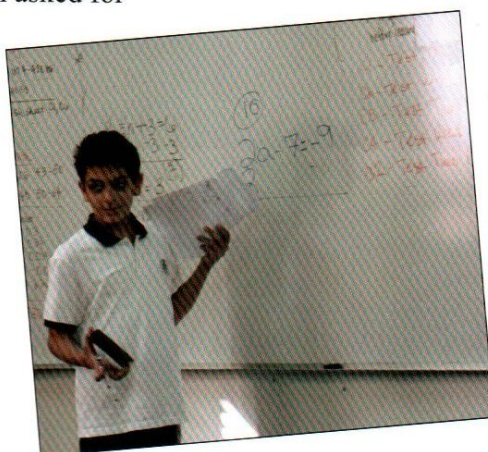

**Problem solving.** An eighth-grade class was trying to solve an algebraic equation on Dec.13. Kamal Eldin Khedir volunteered to go to the board.



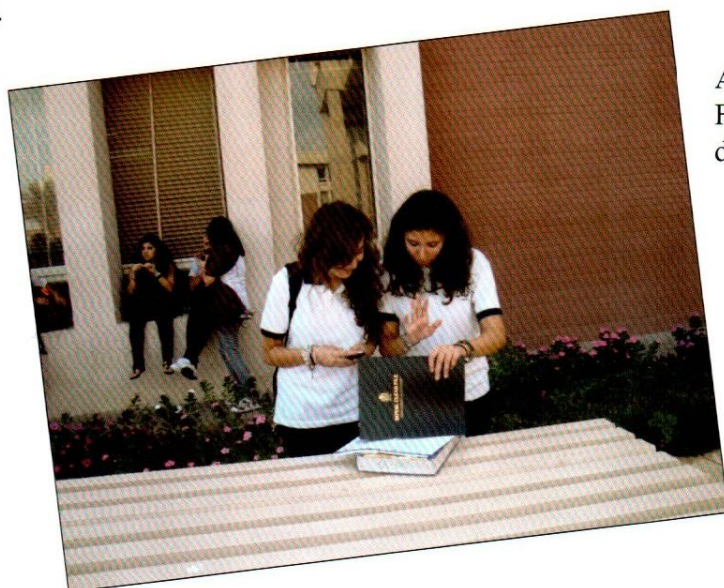

## 1. How did the school start out, when it first got established in Egypt?

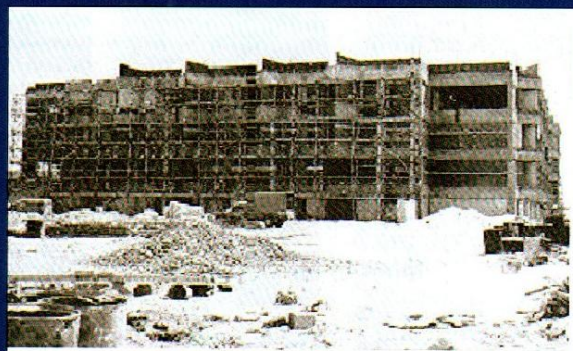
I established the Universal American School in Kuwait in 1976 at the start of the Lebanese civil war. When Iraq invaded Kuwait in 1990, it was the largest American accredited school in the Middle East and had an enrollment of 1,600 students. One year before the Iraqi invasion of Kuwait, I sensed danger ahead and started exploring options for a school in Egypt. When Iraq invaded Kuwait in August 1990, I quickly relocated to Cairo, rented a property and opened the doors of the American International School in Egypt (AISE) with an enrollment of 42 pupils, mostly from our school in Kuwait. The extraordinary beginning led some colleagues in international education to dub AISE "the miracle school". By the end of the year, the school had 250 students and four years later it boasted a fully-equipped, purpose built campus and an enrollment of more than 1,000 students. Ten years later, it moved once again to a magnificent, state-of-the-art school on a 51,000 square meter campus in New Cairo that serves more than 1,400 students. Afterwards, another state of the art branch campus was opened in west Cairo in September 2009.

## 3. What changes have you seen in the school?

The school developed very well and coped with the fast changes in education worldwide. Progress should continue so that AIS remains at the cutting edge.

## 2. Why did you start the school? What is the reason behind it?

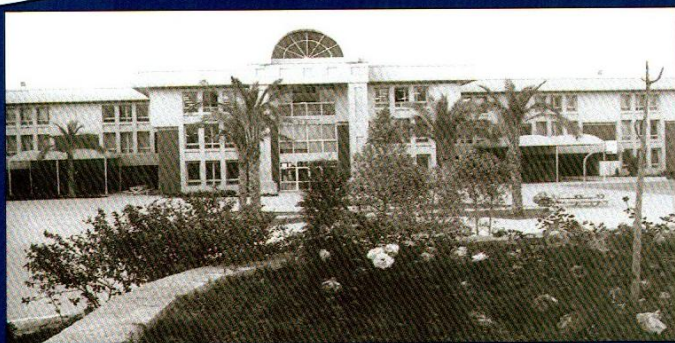
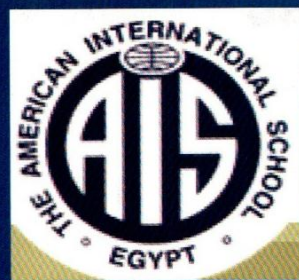
I love Egypt, and I believe that the Arab countries draw strength from a strong Egypt. I expected the great need for such a school to support the desired growth in Egypt.

Being the founder, superintendent and chairman of Educational Services Overseas Limited (ESOL), I established and managed more than fifteen schools across the region. By 2005, ESOL had built one of the most formidable teams of educational professionals in the world. The organization was ready for new challenges. As had happened before in Kuwait and in Egypt, ESOL's success with AISA in Abu Dhabi opened the door to new opportunities in the United Arab Emirates. In 2005, ESOL entered the Dubai market, launching the Universal American School Dubai (UASD) as well as the organization's first British curriculum school, the Deira International School (DIS). UASD and DIS enjoy two of the best school campuses in the region and are part of the Al Futtain Group's beautiful Dubai Festival City development along the Dubai Creek. The organization's reputation and its capabilities were instrumental in the success of UASD and DIS. In the few short years since their opening in 2005, both Dubai schools have grown to serve more than 1,100 students each and are quickly establishing themselves as two of the region's truly outstanding schools.

6. Why did you decide to open the other campus in 6th of October?

Because the expansion and growth of the greater Cairo metropolis with the very busy roads made some students ride buses far more than an hour and a half each way and the reputation AIS enjoys made us enthusiastic about expansion.

5. What are your goals for the next decade?

A few more schools in the Middle East, Europe and the Americas. But at this point in time, my dream of starting a top University is happening in the "Alamein University," Egypt.
