#1 READ COURSE DESCRIPTIONS



ALDERWOOD MIDDLE SCHOOL REQUIRED CLASSES - 7TH GRADE


English Language Arts focuses learning on all areas of communication: reading, writing, listening, and speaking. Students will be inspired to think critically about text to develop analytical thinking, utilize the writing process to write in a variety of forms, practice reading strategies to enhance comprehension, and interact with literature to expand knowledge and improve skills.

The Edmonds Reading Intervention Course is designed to identify reading difficulties and provide systematic, targeted Reading instruction in the areas of phonics & decoding, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension. Students will participate in daily and weekly activities to obtain the necessary skills to achieve grade level reading proficiency. Students are identified and placed in this course using the State (Smarter Balanced Assessment) outcomes from prior academic years, the district (i-Ready) results, and Acadience Reading Program data. This course is taken in addition to English 7 and may replace the student's Elective or Health and Physical Education class.

7th Grade Social Studies is divided into two-semester courses; one semester is Washington State History and the other semester is Medieval History. For WA State history, students will learn about and demonstrate mastery of WA State civics, geography, economics, and history. Successfully passing the WA State History portion is a High School graduation requirement. For the Medieval portion, students will study at least two of the following groups: Europe during feudalism, Meso-America, Japan, China, West Africa, or Stance in stancy as reast two or one informing groups, curepe uning requesting, measurantering, Japan, curing, west variety of stance Empires. Both classes will place a heavy emphasis on reading, writing, and listening skills that students will need to master throughout the year. Near the end of the year, all students will be expected to complete the CBA or Classroom-Based Assessment.

Math 7 is available to all 7th grade students. Students will extend prior learning on a variety of topics in preparation for pre-algebra.


