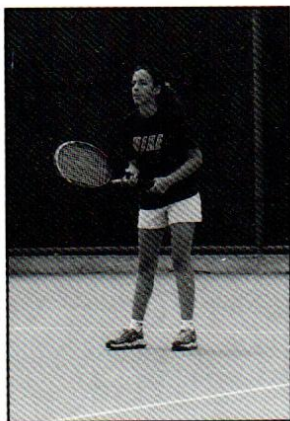
TENNIS
