Estimated Tax Rate

- The Tax Rate is projected to increase by \$10.68 per 1,000 of assessed value, assuming the current assessed value and equalization rate.
- For the average single family home assessed at \$17,822 the increase will be an estimated \$190 per year.

* Town of Greenburgh property reassessments <u>will not</u> impact taxes for the 2016-2017 school year. New property tax assessments will take effect in the 2017-2018 school budget.
