DISCUSSION OF SCHOOL UNIFORMS- Make it an incentive (shirt and khakis) for PBIS points Any thoughts:

Whitney Walker asked a question: Is it every day or once per week? Chair has posed for the uniform to be worn once each week as in incentive. Preparations were in process, but the shift in having to K8 changed; proposal is on hold. May not be happening this year or next year. Thoughts are being considered for the 22-23 school year. Dr. Thomas discussed the benefits: Voted for it in the beginning because of dress code violation and homeless students; will lessen bullying and alternative clothing.

Collins discussed the benefits: It cuts down on the bullying. There was a minor altercation with a student so uniforms would be ideal.

Whitney Walker commented: Agrees to uniform. It assists in alleviating bullying and dismisses labels. Forts discussed the benefits: In concurrence, it will build a familiar culture and helps aside in morale, mitigates bullying.

Chair discussed the process: Roll out as an incentive for students as an explorative year through PBIS. **Gage asked a question:** If parents could not afford, would there be options? Dr. Stephens answered in the affirmative. Possibly purchasing the first set of uniforms for students.
