Action Item - Motion to Call the Meeting to Order – Meg Ricketts called the meeting to order at 4:01 PM.

Action Item - Approve Agenda for September 22, 2020

Meg Ricketts moved to approve the agenda. Betsy Geurin seconded. All in favor.

Action Item - Approve August 11, 2020 Meeting Minutes

The minutes from August 11th were reviewed. Meg Ricketts moved to approve the minutes. Molly Nelson seconded. All in favor.

Discussion Item – Remote Learning Update

Dr. Cheatham provided info regarding back to school. Currently we have entered Phase 3 of reentry, which is 1 full day a week. There were 87 kids present today. Phase 4 will begin on 10/5/20 and will be 2 full days a week, likely Mon/Thurs and Tues/Fri grouping, dependent on households. October 14 will begin Phase 5, full time F2F. The next 3 Wednesdays (9/23, 9/30, and 10/7) will be asynchronous learning days and there will not be live lessons. There will be a combination of pre-recorded lessons, choice boards and catch up work. Beginning tomorrow, 9/23/2020 the staff will begin preparing and planning for simultaneous learning models. The model will be dependent on the number of students returning F2F and those remaining virtual. Enrollment was down as expected and thus one teacher had to be relocated to another school for staffing needs. A 4th grade position was lost, therefore a 4th grade teacher was moved to 1st grade as the 1st grade teacher was the newest hire and was relocated. Current grade numbers are as follows: K-76 (105 projected); 1st-99 (98 projected); 2nd- 114 (131 projected); 3rd- 121 (123 projected); 4th- 112 (123 projected) and 5th- 116 (122 projected).

CCES has approximately 75% of students participating in Phase 3. (K-61; 1st- 75, 2nd-85, 3rd-91, 4th-90, 5th- 85). Though numbers change daily.

Discussion Item – Principal’s Update

Dr. Cheatham shared updates including a decrease in some budget areas due to lower enrollment. The Fulton County survey about return to school has had LOW completion, though the CCES survey has had HIGH completion.

During return to school, students eating in the cafeteria will be rotated to comply with social distancing. Recess time will also be rotated between the park, playground, field and, black top. Each homeroom will stay together, and masks will be worn. Masks also

to be worn for PE, however PE will be held outside as weather permits and social distancing stickers have been added to the gym.

Discussion Item – PTO Update

Victoria Tucker shared updates including several fundraising opportunities currently: Oliver's Labels and Mabel's Labels (\$500), Spirit Wear sales (\$600), Community Partner Renewals (\$3000), PTO membership drive (\$600). PTO has provided agendas for 3-5th, folders for all grades, IXL/PebbleGo, disposable masks, teacher appreciation meals (2 per month).

Discussion – Jeannie Hunt update on Pres/VP SGC training

Jeannie discussed a recent training she attended. A key take away she wished to share was revisiting our norms and goals that were set for our SGC last year. We will plan to address at the next meeting.
